APPLICATION PROCEDURE FOR ENTRANCE EXAMINATION

Online Submission of Registration and Application Form

1. REQUIREMENTS

- a) **GJUM registration number** (will be generated on Samarth Portal of Guru Jambheshwar University through the given link: <https://gjumadm.samarth.edu.in/index.php>)
- b) **Valid Email ID**
- c) **Aadhar No.**
- d) **Active Mobile Number:** The Mobile number should be with the applicant at the time of formfilling. Login Credentials (Registration no and password) will be sent to this mobile number and email ID.
- e) **Alternate Mobile Number** (Preferably of parent)
- f) **Scanned Photo in JPEG format** (Maximum upload size is 50 KB only)
- g) **Scanned Signature in JPEG format** (Maximum upload size is 50 KB only)
- h) **Photo ID proof** (Any one of the following for entering the details at the designated place in the online registration form): Aadhar Card/ Voter ID/ Driving License/Passport.
- i) **Registration fee** of Rs 150/- + **Entrance Application Fee** of Rs 800/-
- j) **EWS Certificate:** Applicants claiming Economically Weaker Section (EWS) seats must choose "Yes" in the personal Information page. The EWS certificate must be uploaded on the same page, where photo and signature are uploaded. The EWS certificate issued by the competent authority will be needed at the time of counselling.
- k) **Category Certificate for Reservation**
 - The number of caste certificate issued by the competent authority will have to be entered for availing the benefit of reservation for OBC, SC and ST categories. The validity of these certificates will be verified from the Government website. (The Certificate must be uploaded on the same page, where photo and signature are uploaded) Applicants of the OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) category would require the certificate (issued after 1 August 2022) at the time of counselling/Admission.
 - Only those candidates who are domiciled in Uttar Pradesh shall be eligible for the reservation benefit under the Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backwards Class categories. SC/ST/OBC candidates from **other states are not eligible** for reservation under the **state quota**.
 - The candidates who have passed the eligibility examination from Uttar Pradesh shall be considered as U.P. domiciles. If any candidate has cleared the eligibility examination from another state, he/she shall be required to furnish a domicile certificate from U.P. to get the benefit of reservation.

2. GUIDELINES FOR FILLING REGISTRATION/APPLICATION FORM

Step 1. Generation of Guru Jambheshwar University Moradabad Registration Number (GJUMRN) Through Samarth Portal by given link

- a) Go to the Registration Page on Samarth Portal of Guru Jambheshwar University website with unique E-mail ID and active mobile number through the following link <https://gjumadm.samarth.edu.in/index.php> and complete the registration process.

- b) After completing the registration with OTP verification, go to the login page of the Samarth Portal. After login to the Dashboard the applicant has to fill complete profile and other details. The applicant must upload the Photo, signature, ID proof and other supporting document for category/quota (if applied for).
- c) After filling out the profile, the applicant is shown a final preview page. Once the details are confirmed, the applicant moves to the Payment section.
- d) The applicant has to submit Registration fee of Rs. 150/- online through UPI/NEFT/DEBIT CARD/Internet Banking. After successful payment, the applicant will return to the dashboard to check his/her registration status.

Step 2. Filling of Application Form

After completion of registration, applicant will have to choose the program (LL.M/LL.B/M.Ed.) to fill the entrance exam application form. The details filled in the GJUMRN form will reflect automatically in the application form.

Step 3. Educational Qualifications

- a) Applicants have to fill their educational qualifications 10th onwards. Enter the marks and other details as mentioned in the mark sheets.
- b) For candidates who have appeared in their qualifying exams but result is not yet declared, they have to fill the details of previous year. Candidates qualifying the entrance exam will have to furnish the copy of marksheet of final year at the time of Counselling.

Step 4. Preview

Applicants can preview all the entries made at this point. If there is some error, they can edit it or start the entire process again. The applicants must upload all the required documents related to their educational qualifications.

Step 5. Entrance Examination Fee

- a) After completing the entries and uploading the necessary documents, applicant can submit the form and proceed for payment of the entrance examination fees.
- b) Entrance examination fees of Rs. 800/- can be submitted online by any of the following ways: Debit Card/Net Banking/UPI/NEFT

Step 6. Print Application form

Applicants can print their application form and fee receipt to complete the application process. Applicants have to retain a printout of their application form which may be needed later.

NOTE: Applicants are advised to check all the data they have entered, before submitting the application fee. If there is some error, they can edit it or start the entire process again. Once they have submitted the application fee the data submitted in the registration page cannot be edited under any circumstances.

The admission to LL.B. course shall be made on the basis of merit in the LL.B. Entrance Exam 2025.

Date of Entrance Exam: 15th July, 2025, Tuesday at 10:00 AM

About the Programme: The 3-year LL.B. is a professional degree programme that is open to graduates from all disciplines. It is a qualifying degree for admission to legal practice. The programme meets all requirements of the Bar Council of India. After completing a 3-year LL.B. course, graduates have numerous career paths to pursue, including becoming advocates, legal advisors, corporate lawyers, or working in government services. They can also opt for judicial services, legal research, or teaching roles.

A. Eligibility: The eligibility criteria for admission to LL.B. (Three Years) Degree course shall be as follows:-

- a) An applicant who has graduated in any discipline of knowledge from a University established by an Act of Parliament or by a State Legislature or an equivalent national institution recognized as a deemed to be university or foreign university recognized as equivalent to the status of an Indian University by an authority competent to declare equivalence may apply for a three year's degree program in Law.

Note: The applicants who have obtained 10+2 or graduation/post-graduation through open universities system directly without having any basic

qualification for pursuing such studies **are not eligible** for admission in the LL.B course. (B.C.I. Circular No. LE CIR: 02/2010 dt. 20.12.2010)

- b) For the purpose of applying for and getting admitted in LL.B. (Three Years) Degree course the applicant must have obtained a Bachelor's Degree in any discipline from a UGC recognized university with the minimum 45% of the total marks for General Category, 42% of the total marks in case of OBC category and 40% of the total marks in case of SC and ST category candidate. Provided that such a minimum qualifying marks shall not automatically entitle a person to get admission in the LL.B. (Three Years) Degree program but only shall entitle the person concerned to apply in the Entrance Exam.
- c) Reservation rules will be followed as per the U.P. State Government orders.
- d) The admission to LL.B. (Three Years) course shall be made on the basis of merit in the Entrance Exam and the weightage marks.

Note: The students who have appeared/appearing in their Bachelor Degree last semester/year exam and, if the result is awaited, such candidates may apply, but the admission will depend on their securing the minimum eligibility marks prescribed above.

B. Syllabus of Entrance Exam

The entrance exam paper of LL.B. (Three Years) will consist of 100 questions on following subjects:

1. General Hindi - 20 Questions
2. General English- 20 Questions
3. General Knowledge, Current Affairs, Legal Reasoning - 60 Questions

C. Entrance Exam Paper/Examination Procedure:

- The LL.B. entrance exam will be conducted offline of 2 hours duration.
- The LL.B. entrance exam will be based on objective type questions.
- The paper shall comprise of 100 multiple choice type questions (both in Hindi and English medium)
- All objective questions will have four options with single correct answer.
- For each correct answer 4 mark will be awarded. One mark will be deducted for any wrong answer.
- In case, two or more candidates obtain equal marks in entrance exam, the merit will be decided on the basis of higher marks obtained in the qualifying (eligibility) examination and if they are also equal, then the merit will be decided on the basis of seniority in age.
- The original OMR and question paper have to be returned by the candidate before leaving examination hall, where as carbon copy of OMR may be retained by the candidate.

G. Counselling & Seat Allocation

- Counselling will be conducted at university campus for shortlisted candidates.
- Seats will be allocated based on merit & preferences.
 - Counselling fee: Rs. 2500/- (Rs. 500/- non-refundable and Rs. 2000/- will be adjusted in admission fees after confirmation of seats).

H. Admission Criteria

After the allocation of the seat, the candidate will visit the allotted college and College complete the admission process as per GJU Admission Guidelines with proper document verification.

Reservation: Reservation of seats for admission in each college will be done on the basis of the total number of seats in that college as follows-

- The children of ordinary (civilian) employees of the Security Department will not be entitled to the benefits of the Security Service Personnel category.
- A maximum of 5% of students from states outside Uttar Pradesh can be admitted on the basis of merit list. All such candidates will be considered under General/Unreserved category.
- The certificate of Other Backward Class (Non-Creamy Layer) will be valid only dated after 01 August 2022.

The admission to LL.M. course shall be made on the basis of merit in the LL.M. Entrance Exam 2025.

Date of Entrance Exam: 15th July, 2025 (Tuesday) at 10:00 AM

About the Programme: The LL.M. programme equips students with advanced knowledge in legal principles, justice, and governance. Emphasising robust research acumen and subject-matter expertise, the curriculum and teaching pedagogy concentrate on domestic, international, and comparative law subjects. The Master of Laws (LL.M.) degree offers a wide range of career opportunities in both the public and private sectors. LL.M. graduates can pursue careers as legal consultants, corporate lawyers, legal advisors, and in various roles within government and non-governmental organizations. They can also work in specialized fields like international law, intellectual property law, and cyber law, or pursue academic careers in law schools.

A. Eligibility:

The eligibility criteria for admission to LL.M. (Two Year) Degree course shall be as follows:-

- For **General** category and **Other Backward Classes (OBC)** candidates, a 3 year/5 year LL.B. Degree from the UGC/BCI approved University with at least **50% marks** or an equivalent grade point in the aggregate for Two-Year Course LL.M..
- The candidates belonging to **Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe (SC/ST)** having a 3 year/5 year LL.B. Degree from the UGC/BCI approved University with at least **45% marks** or an equivalent grade point in the aggregate for Two-Year LL.M. Course.
- Reservation rules will be followed as per the U.P. State Government orders.

The admission to LL.M. course shall be made on the basis of merit in the LL.M. Entrance Exam.

Note: The students who have appeared/appearing in their Qualifying Degree last semester/year exam and, if the result is awaited, such candidates may apply, but the admission will depend on their securing the minimum eligibility marks prescribed above.

- ✓ The LL.M. entrance exam will be conducted offline of 2 hours duration.
- ✓ The LL.M. entrance exam will be based on objective type OMR based questions.
- ✓ The paper shall comprise of 100 multiple choice type questions (in English and Hindi medium)
- ✓ All objective questions will have four options with single correct answer.
- ✓ For each correct answer 4 mark will be awarded. One mark will be deducted for any wrong answer.
- ✓ The merit list will be prepared purely on the basis of marks obtained in entrance exam. In case, two or more candidates obtain equal marks in entrance exam, the merit will be decided on the basis of higher marks obtained in the qualifying (eligibility) examination and if they are also equal, then the merit will be decided on the basis of seniority in age.
- ✓ The original OMR, and question booklet have to be returned by the candidate before leaving examination hall, where as carbon copy of OMR may be retained by the candidate.

H. Admission Criteria

- ✓ In LL.M. (2 Years Course), admissions will be made strictly on the basis of merit in the Entrance Exam. However, minimum required eligibility qualification criteria must be fulfilled.
- ✓ Maximum 5% student of other states will be allowed for admission.
- ✓ Candidates will be allotted seats strictly according to merit.
- ✓ Candidates have to ensure that he/she is eligible for appearing in the admission exam. Merely appearing in the admission exam does not guarantee the admission unless eligibility conditions are fulfilled at the time of admission. Admission to this course is through an entrance exam conducted by Guru Jambheshwar University, Moradabad. The orders of the Uttar Pradesh Government, U G C, U P Universities Act 1973 and Regulations of the NCTE will be followed for this purpose.

PROGRAMME DURATION: The Master of Education Programme is a full-time programme for duration of two academic years.

The M.Ed. Entrance exam will be conducted for the admission in M.Ed. programme running in the affiliated colleges of Guru Jambheshwar University, Moradabad.

A. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Candidates seeking admission to the M.Ed. programme should have obtained at least 50% marks or an equivalent grade from any institution recognised by U.G.C. in the following programmes:

- B.Ed.
- B.El.Ed.
- BA B.Ed. and B.Sc. B.Ed. or
- D.El.Ed. with Undergraduate Degree (with 50% marks in each).

There will be relaxation of 5% marks for SC/ST Candidates

Final year students awaiting results of their qualifying exam may also apply, subject to submission of qualifying marks before counselling/admission.

A. SYLLABUS FOR M.Ed. ENTRANCE EXAM

The entrance exam paper will include the questions based on:

- Current affairs
- General knowledge
- Logical reasoning
- Teaching aptitude
- Educational technology
- Philosophical foundations of education
- Psychological foundations of education
- Sociological foundations of education and
- Emerging problems of Indian education system.

B. Entrance Exam Paper/Examination Procedure

- The Entrance exam for M.Ed. (2 years course) will be based on objective type questions.
- The paper shall comprise of 100 multiple choice type questions for 2 hours duration in Hindi and English languages.
- All objective questions will have four options with single correct answers.
- Four marks shall be awarded for each correct answer.
- One mark will be deducted for each wrong answer.
- No deduction will, however, be made if no response is indicated for a question.
- More than one answer indicated against a question will be deemed as an incorrect response.
- The merit list will be prepared purely on the basis of marks obtained in entrance examination.
- The candidates have to return the original OMR and question booklet before leaving the examination, however the carbon copy of OMR may be retained by the candidate.
- The candidate shall not be allowed to leave the examination hall before the completion of the examination as per time schedule.

F. Result of Entrance Exam

G. Counselling & Seat Allocation

- Counselling shall be conducted at university campus for Shortlisted candidates.
- Seats shall be allocated based on merit & preferences
 - Counselling fee: Rs. 2500/- (Rs. 500/- non-refundable and Rs. 2000/- will be adjusted in fees after confirmation of seats).

H. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- Admission shall be granted on the basis of merit, determined by the marks obtained in the Entrance Examination.
- Reservation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD and other applicable categories shall be as per the rules of the State Government, whichever is applicable.
- Maximum 5% students of other states will be allowed for admission.
- Final year students awaiting results of their qualifying exam may also apply, subject to submission of qualifying marks before admission.
- The University reserves the right to cancel any admission at any stage. The prospective candidates are advised to keep visiting the University website (www.gjum.ac.in) regularly for announcements, notices, and updates, because no separate information shall be sent to any prospective candidate.
- In case, two or more candidates obtain equal marks in entrance exam of a course, the merit will be decided on the basis of higher marks obtained in the qualifying (eligibility) examination and if they are also equal, then the merit will be decided on the basis of seniority in age.
- The candidates appearing in the final year/last semester of the qualifying examination may be allowed to appear only provisionally in the Entrance Exam. However, their position in the Merit List will be subject to fulfilling the eligibility requirements.
- Candidates found using unfair means in the Entrance Exam will not be allowed admission and will also be debarred from any future Entrance Exam.
- The admission of students to the course shall be provisional and will be confirmed by the Admission Committee of the affiliated college only after verification of the original certificates.
- For admission, the claim of the applicants included in a particular Merit List shall cease after the scheduled reporting time.
- No candidate should be permitted to switch admission to other courses (self-financed or regular) without completion/cancellation of the first one.

RESERVATION: Reservation of seats for admission in each college will be done on the basis of the total number of seats in that college as follows-

Vertical Reservation:

Scheduled Caste (SC)	21%

For economically weaker sections of General Category (EWS)	Reservation up to the limit of 10% will be allowed as per the notification/government order of Uttar Pradesh Government. (The said 10% seats will be in addition to the approved seats)

Horizontal Reservation in each category as per Govt. Rules

Physically Challenged	3% (In every College/Course)
Defence Personnel	5% (In every College/Course)
Freedom fighter	2% (In every College/Course)
Women	20% Minimum (In every College/Course)
